

Paarhammer takes out AWA Commercial Windows Award



The Australian Windows Association awarded Paarhammer 'Best Use of Windows & Doors in Commercial Buildings' at their recent conference on the Gold Coast.

Paarhammer received the award for their work on Saffire Freycinet, the new coastal sanctuary on the East Coast of Tasmania. Designed by Morris Nunn Architects, Saffire was built by Fairbrother Construction.

Paarhammer manufactured, supplied and installed doors for each of the 20 accommodation suites, lift-slide doors, bi-fold doors and bi-fold window for treatment rooms and pivot doors for the main building including the entrance doors. There was a requirement for extra large sizes, all double-glazed and with special seals.

Client's needs were for high energy efficiency and acoustic benefits, especially between individual units and for all treatment/spa rooms. Windows and doors had to have a premium feel and a high level of proven sustainability.

The overall outcome is a stunningly beautiful building complex with many sustainable features, sympathetic to the environment and with a minimal footprint.
