Viridian PyroGuard40 double glazing compliments the products, providing a shield against radiant heat and flying embers. Double seals protect against the onslaught of radiant heat and smoke and also draught prove windows and doors.

People building in bush land often like to use natural building materials. It is now possible to combine aesthetics and design freedom of timber with safety in bushfire prone areas. Dwellings in zones up to BAL-40 and FZ using Paarhammer windows and doors do not require metal screens for openable sashes.
